Check all bolts, screws and fasteners periodically and tighten them if necessary.


1-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY





STEP 1


Attach the chair back (A) to the seat frame (B) by sliding the brackets on the chair back (A) into the glides on the seat frame (B) as shown below.

Once the back frame has been locked into place, secure the fabric flap into position using the Velcro strips.

NOTE: Both sides must be inserted into the base at the same time. This step is best performed with 2 people.









NOTE:
