## Helpful Hints

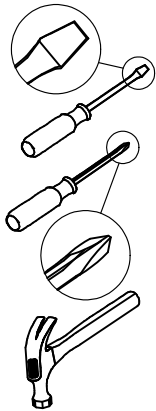
PEOPLE NEEDED FOR ASSEMBLY: 1-2

- Open your item in the area you plan to keep it to avoid excessive heavy lifting.
- Identify, sort and count the parts before attempting assembly.
- Compression dowels are lightly tapped in with a hammer.
- Make sure to always face the point on the top of the Cam Lock towards the outer edge.
- Use all the nails provided for the back panel and spread them out equally.
- Back panel must be used to make sure your unit is sturdy.
- Do NOT use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners on this item.
- Never push, pull, or drag your furniture.





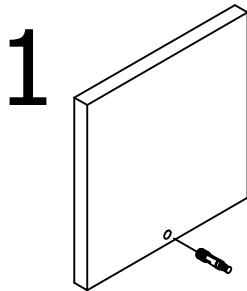
## Before You Start



- ✓ Read through each step carefully and follow the proper order
- ✓ Separate and count all your parts and hardware  
Parts are labeled on the surface or edge of the part
- ✓ Give yourself enough room for the assembly process
- ✓ Have the following tools: Flat Head Screwdriver, #2 Phillips Head Screwdriver and Hammer
- ✓ Caution: If using a power drill or power screwdriver for screwing, please be aware to slow down and stop when screw is tight. Failure to do so may result in stripping the screw.

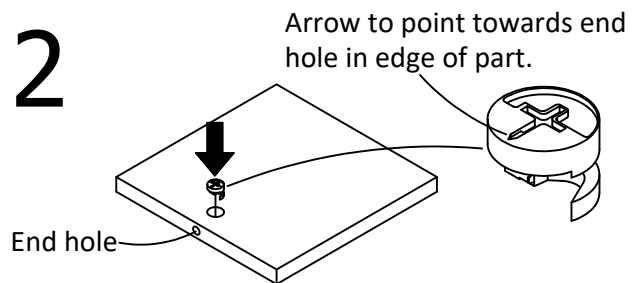
## Cam Lock Fastening System

This Cam Lock Fastening System will be used throughout the assembly process.



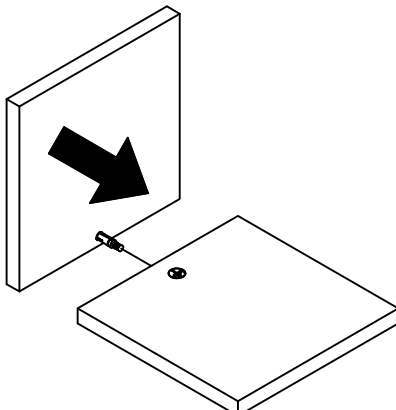
Press CAM BOLT into hole.

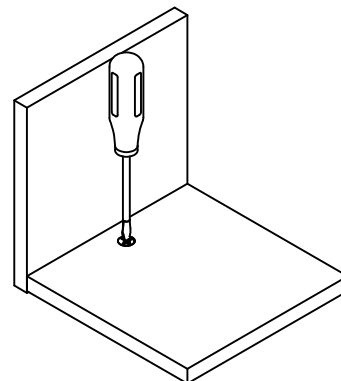
Press CAM LOCK into hole.

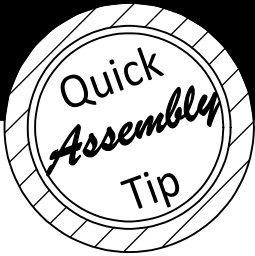


Press parts together so CAM BOLT inserts into edge hole.

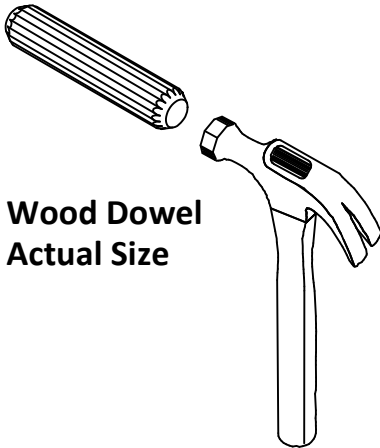
Using a screwdriver, turn the CAM LOCK clockwise to lock the CAM LOCK and CAM BOLT into their holes and fastening parts together.



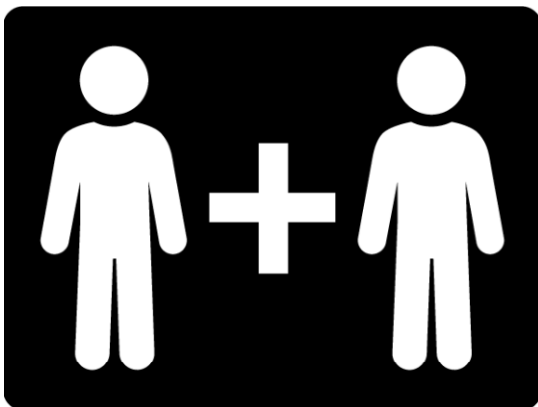
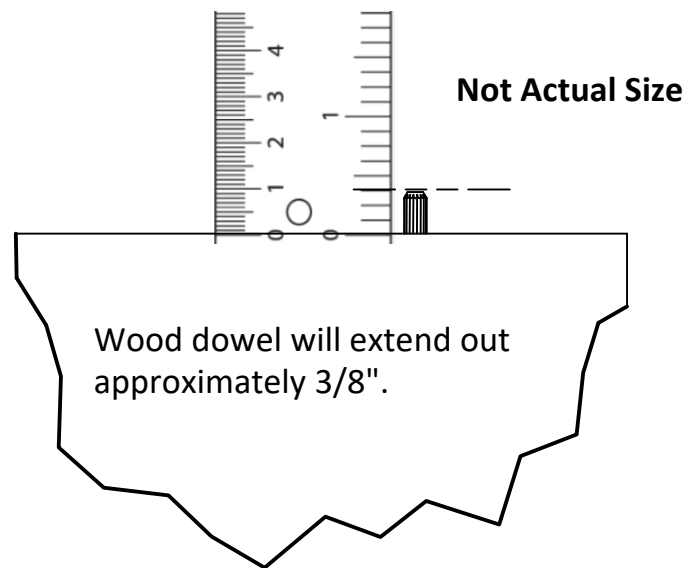
# Before You Start

You may need to **lightly tap** the wood dowels with a hammer into the holes during your assembly process.



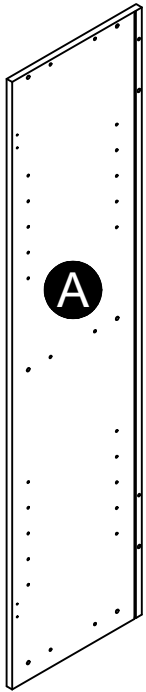
Wood Dowel  
Actual Size



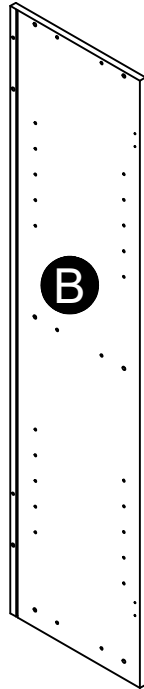

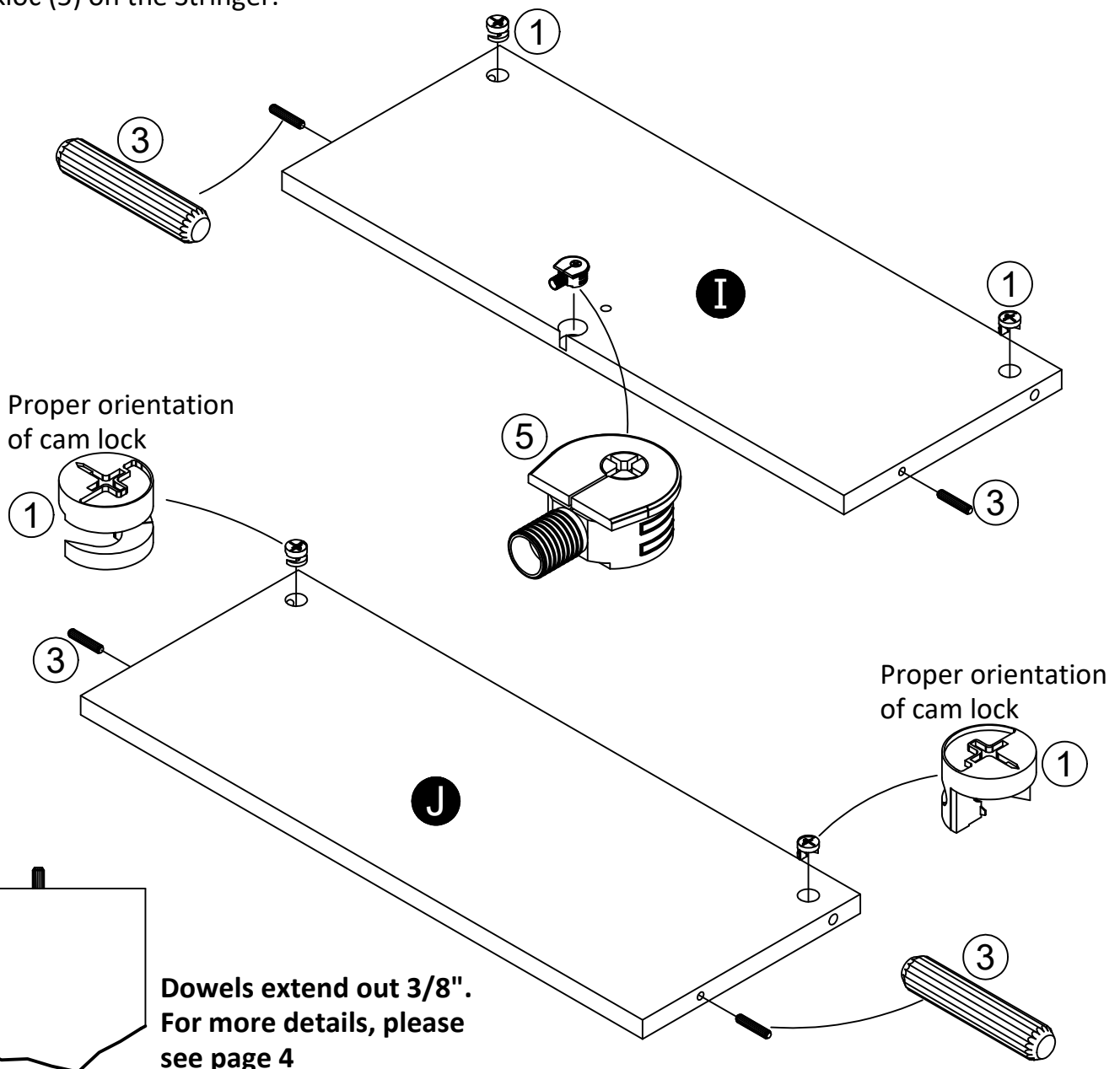
Insert four cam locks (1), four wood dowels (3) and two catch kits (8) into the Fixed Shelf (E).



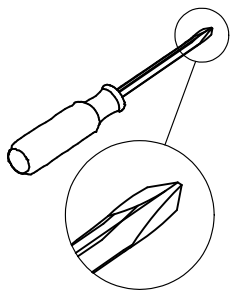

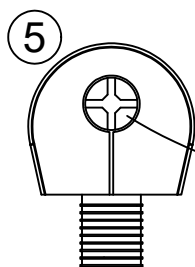
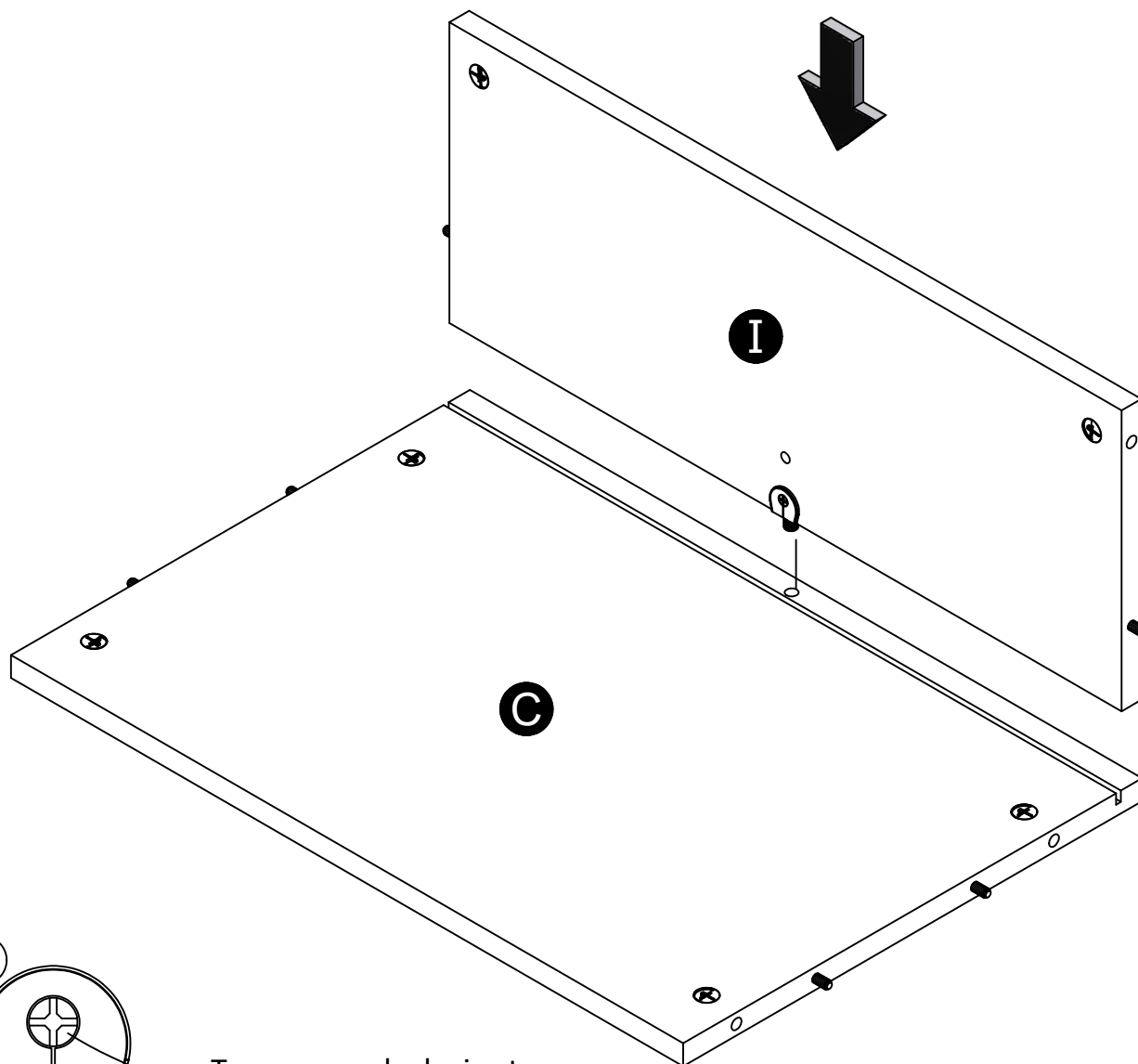
Insert four cam locks (1), (two on the Stringer (I) and two on the Lower Stringer (J)), four wood dowels (3), (two on the Stringer (I) and two on the Lower Stringer (J)) and one Quickloc (5) on the Stringer.



## STEP 7

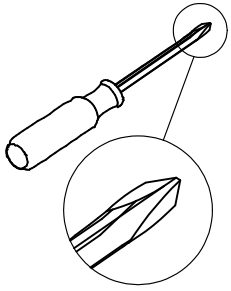


Position the Springer (I) with the quickloc (5) so the quickloc engage the hole in the Top (C).



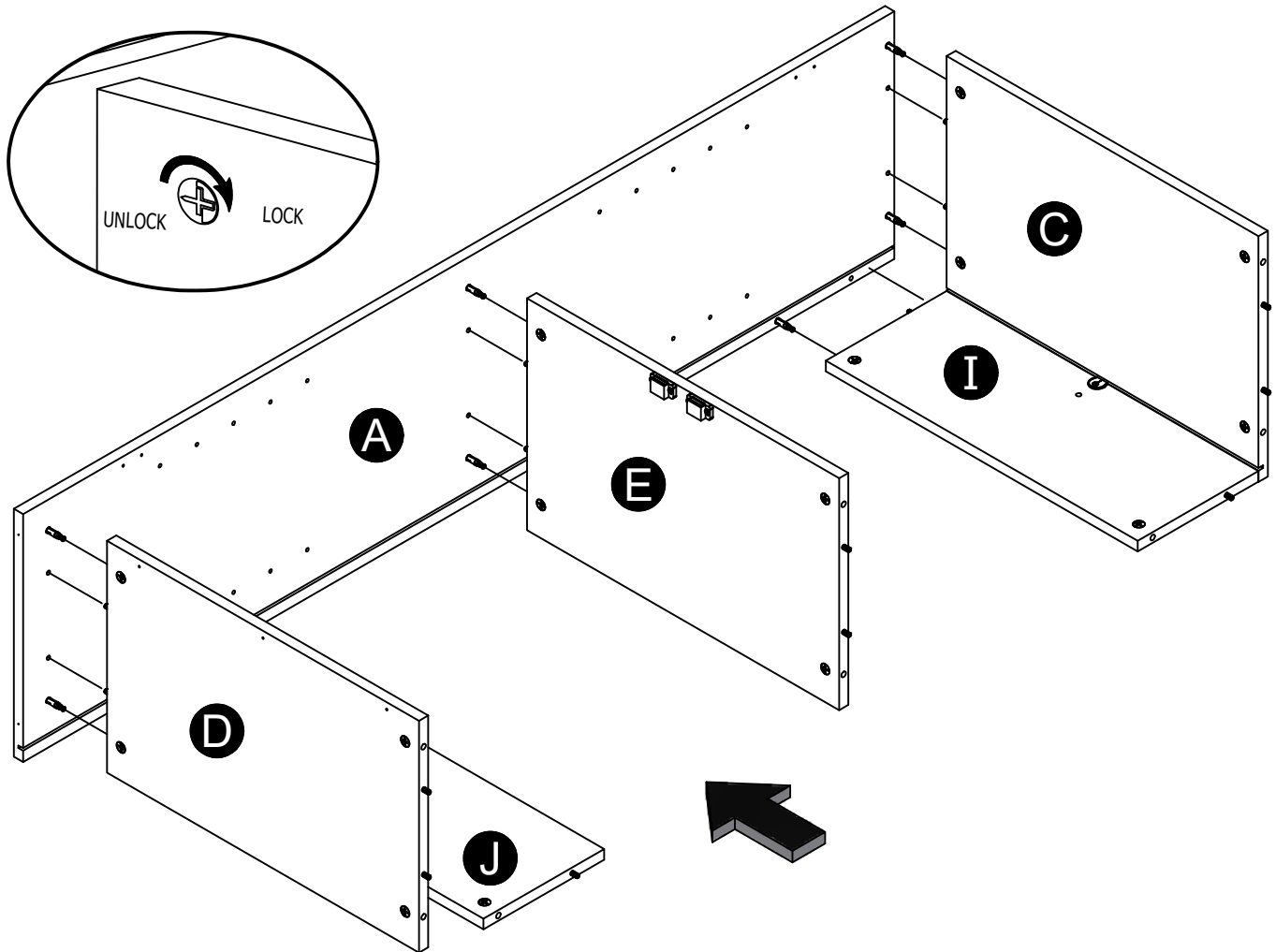
Turn screw clockwise to lock parts together.

## STEP 8

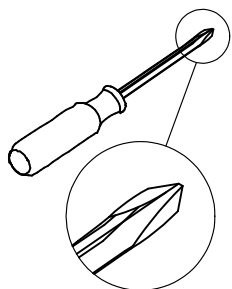


Engage the cam bolts (2) in the Left Panel (A) into the cam locks (1) in the Top (C), Stringer (I), Fixed Shelf (E), Bottom (D) and Lower Stringer (J).  
Turn clockwise to lock in place.

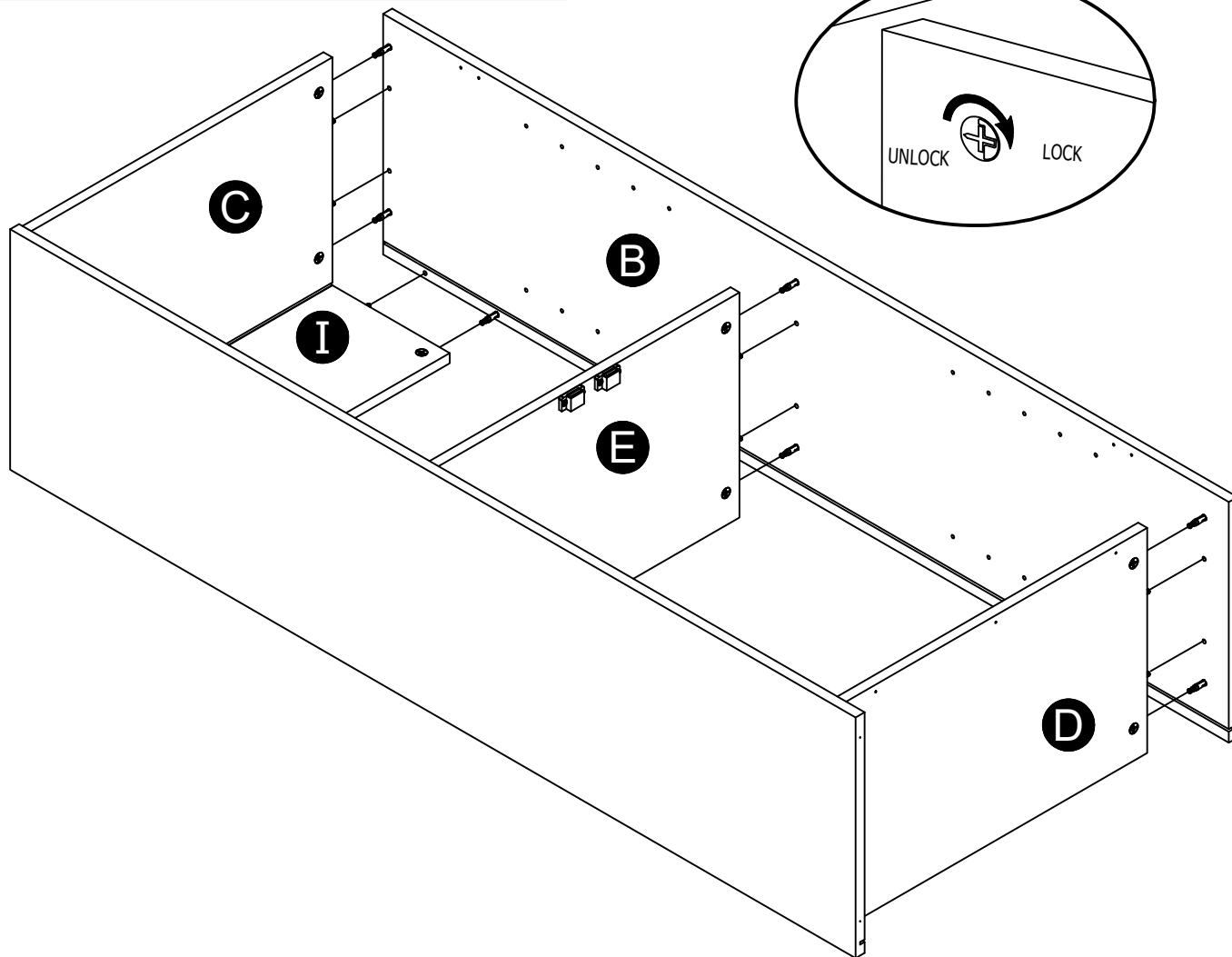
## STEP 9



Engage the cam bolts (2) in the Right Panel (B) into the cam locks (1) in the Top (C), Stringer (I), Fixed Shelf (E), Bottom (D) and Lower Stringer (J).

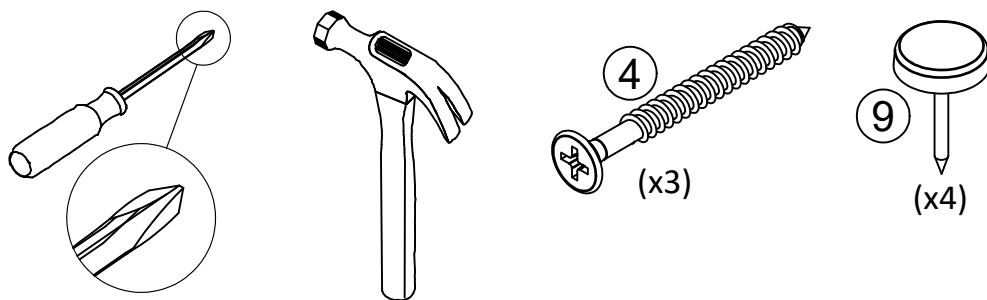
Turn clockwise to lock in place.

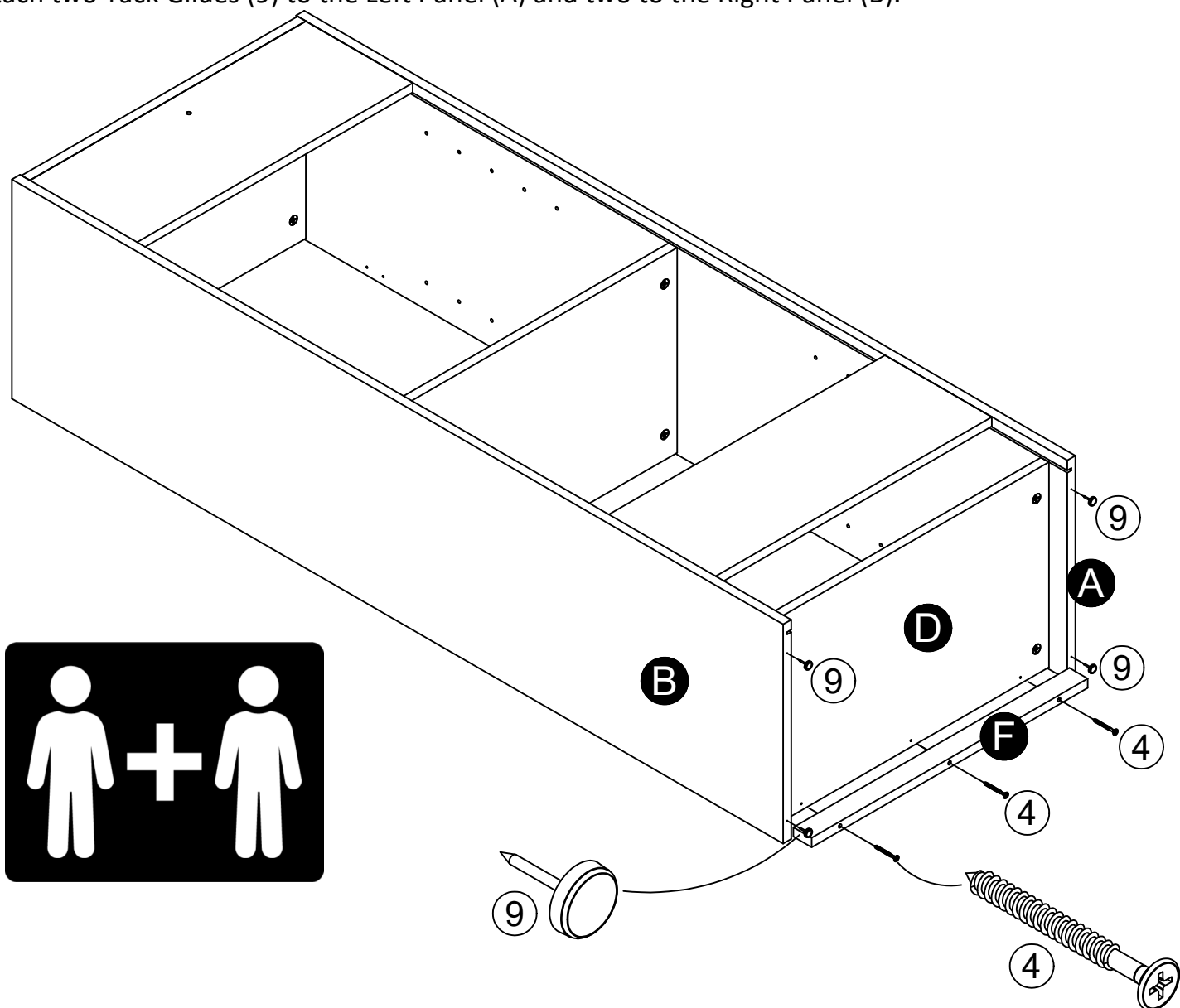


## STEP 10



Place the unit on its front.

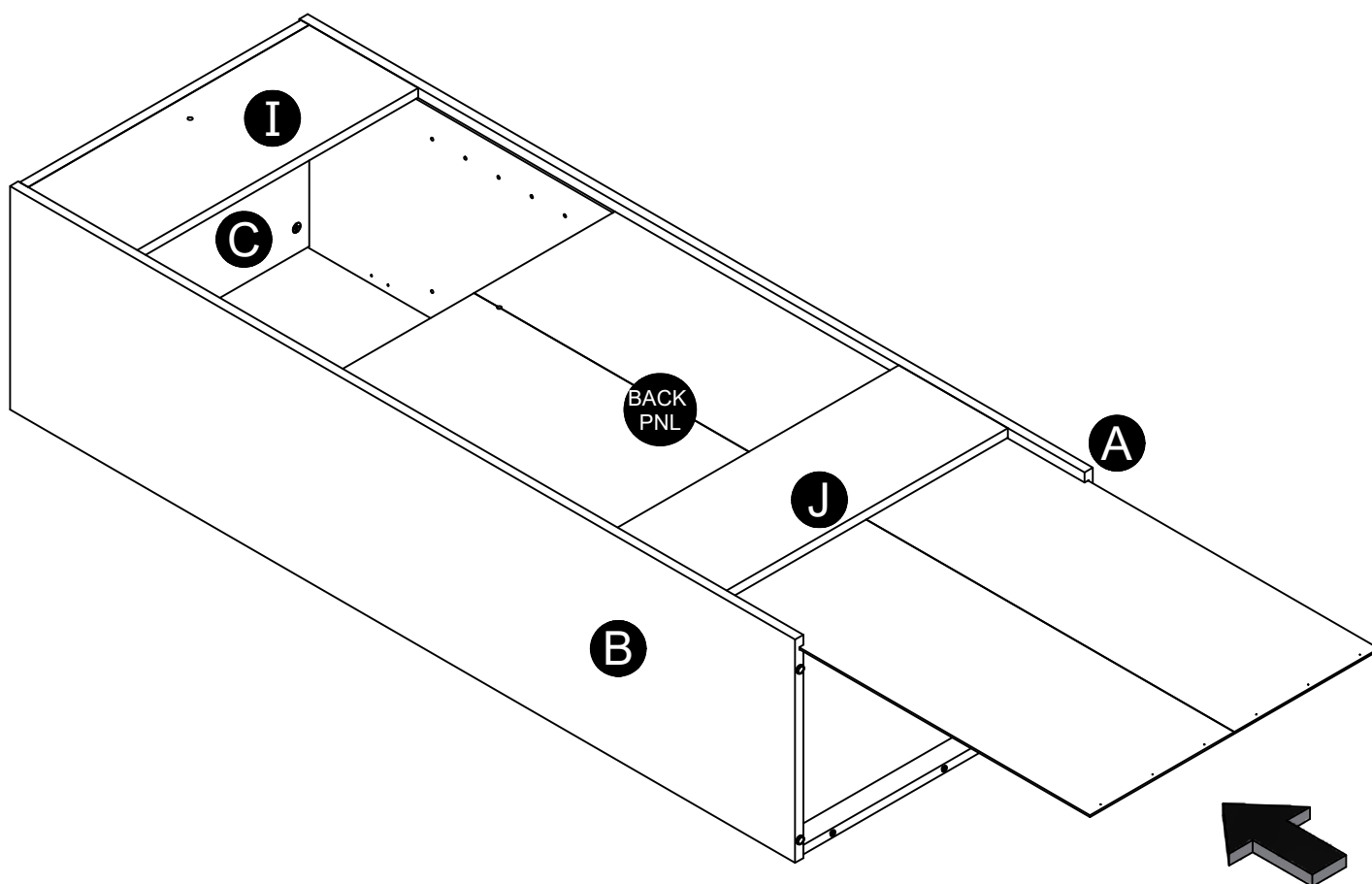
Insert three screws (4) through the Kick (F) and into the holes in the Bottom (D). Using a hammer, attach two Tack Glides (9) to the Left Panel (A) and two to the Right Panel (B).



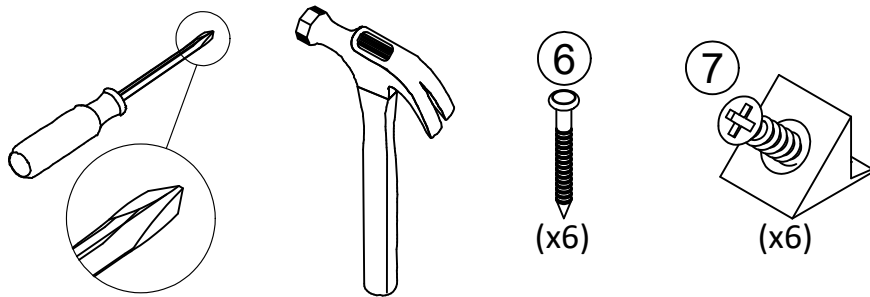
# STEP 11

**IMPORTANT!** THE BACK PANEL IS A STRUCTURAL PART OF THIS UNIT AND MUST BE INSTALLED PROPERLY.

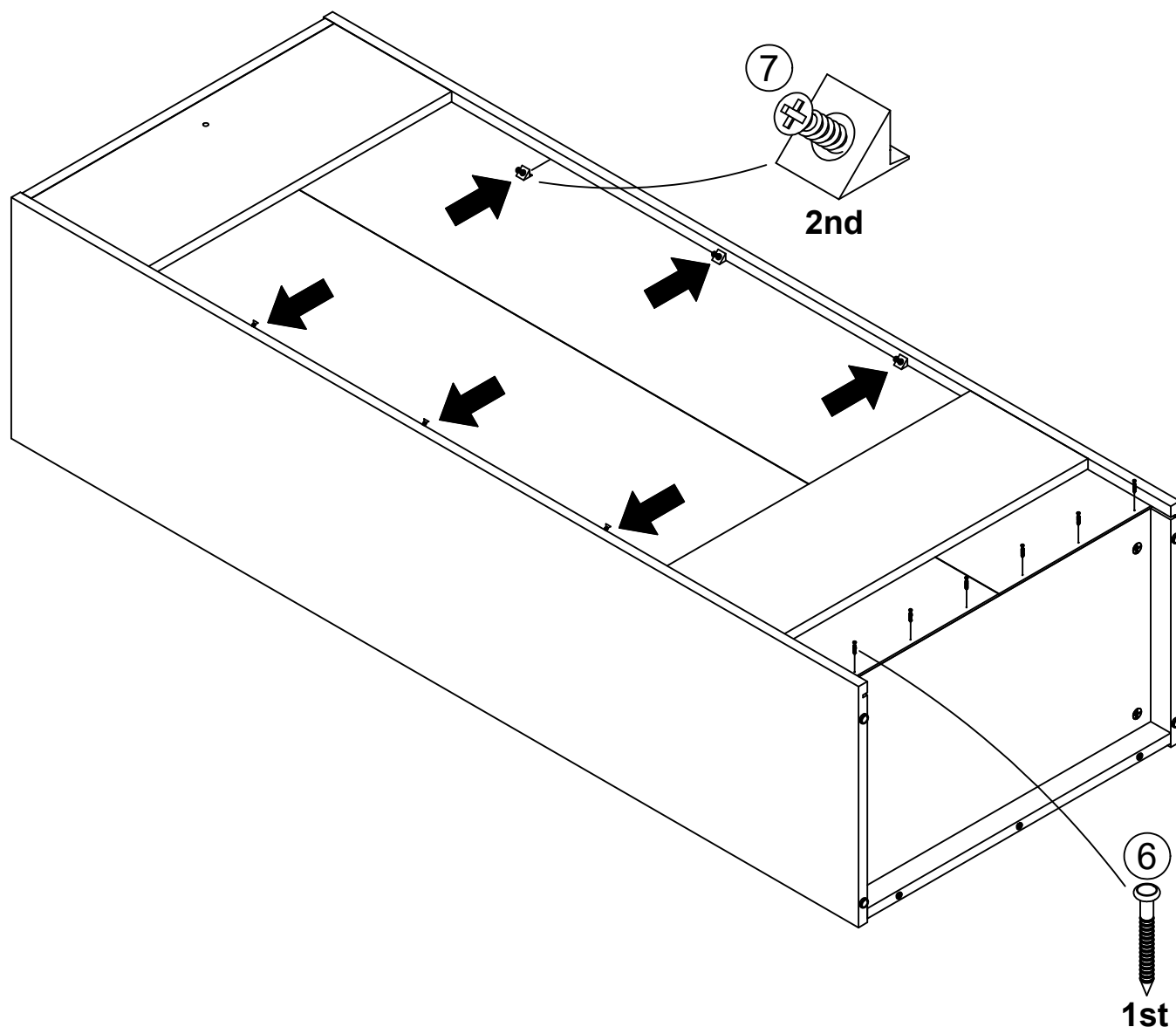
Unfold the back panel. With the finished surface facing down, slide the back panel into the groove in the Left and Right Panels (A&B) seating into the groove in the Top (C). Note, the back panel will be under the Stringer (I) and Lower Stringer (J).



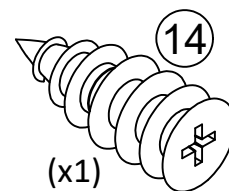
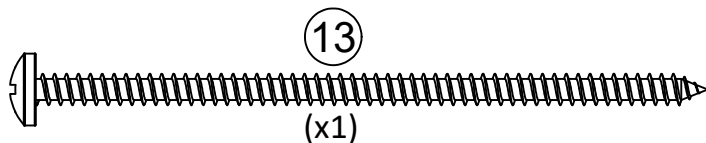
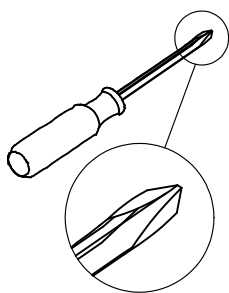
## STEP 12



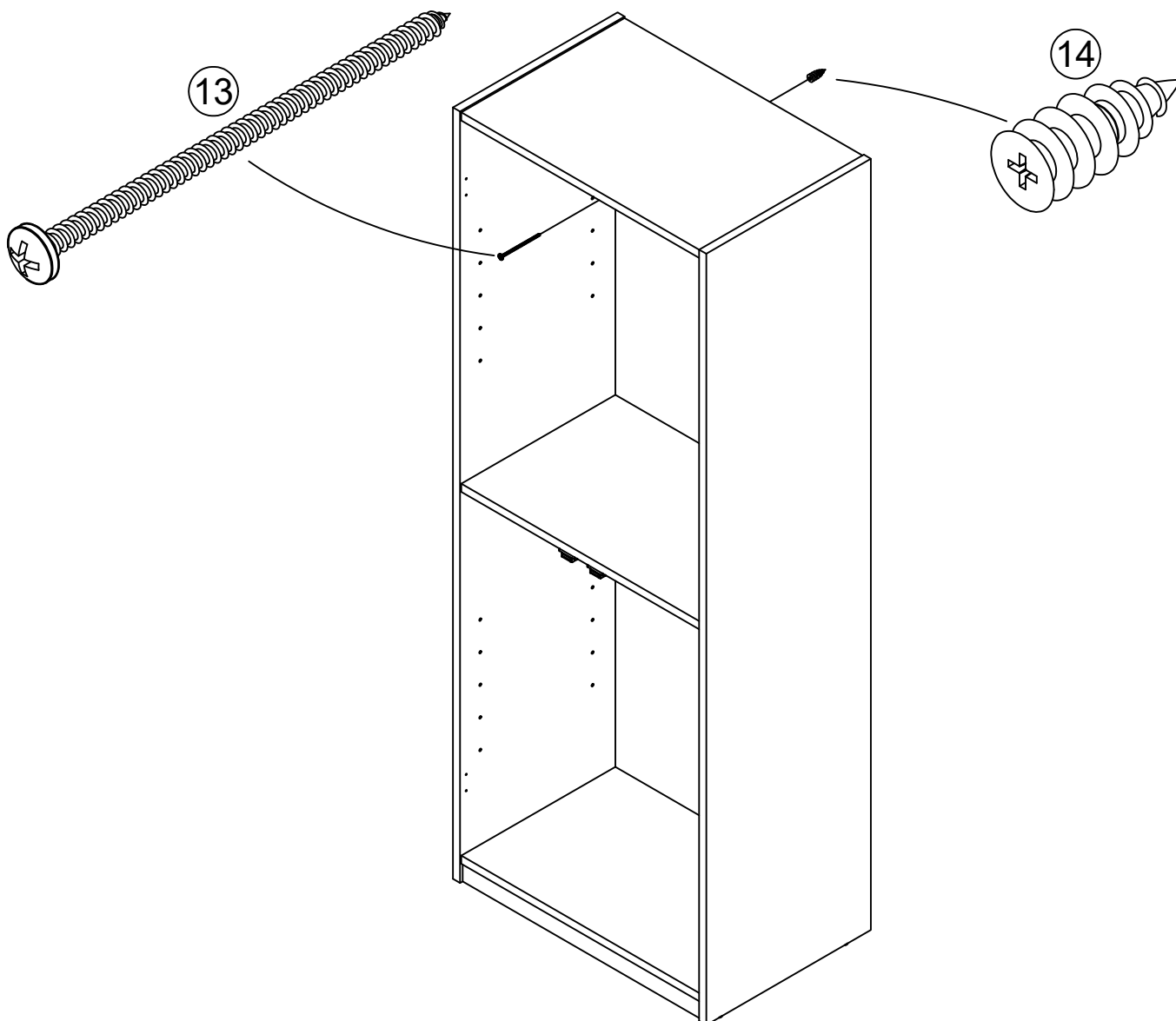
Attach the bottom Back Panel to back edge of Bottom (D) using six nails (6). Position the six wedges (7) on the Back Panels and slide the lip into the groove. Tighten screw to lock in place.



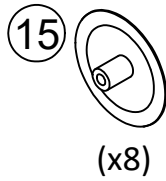
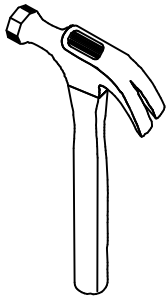
## STEP 13



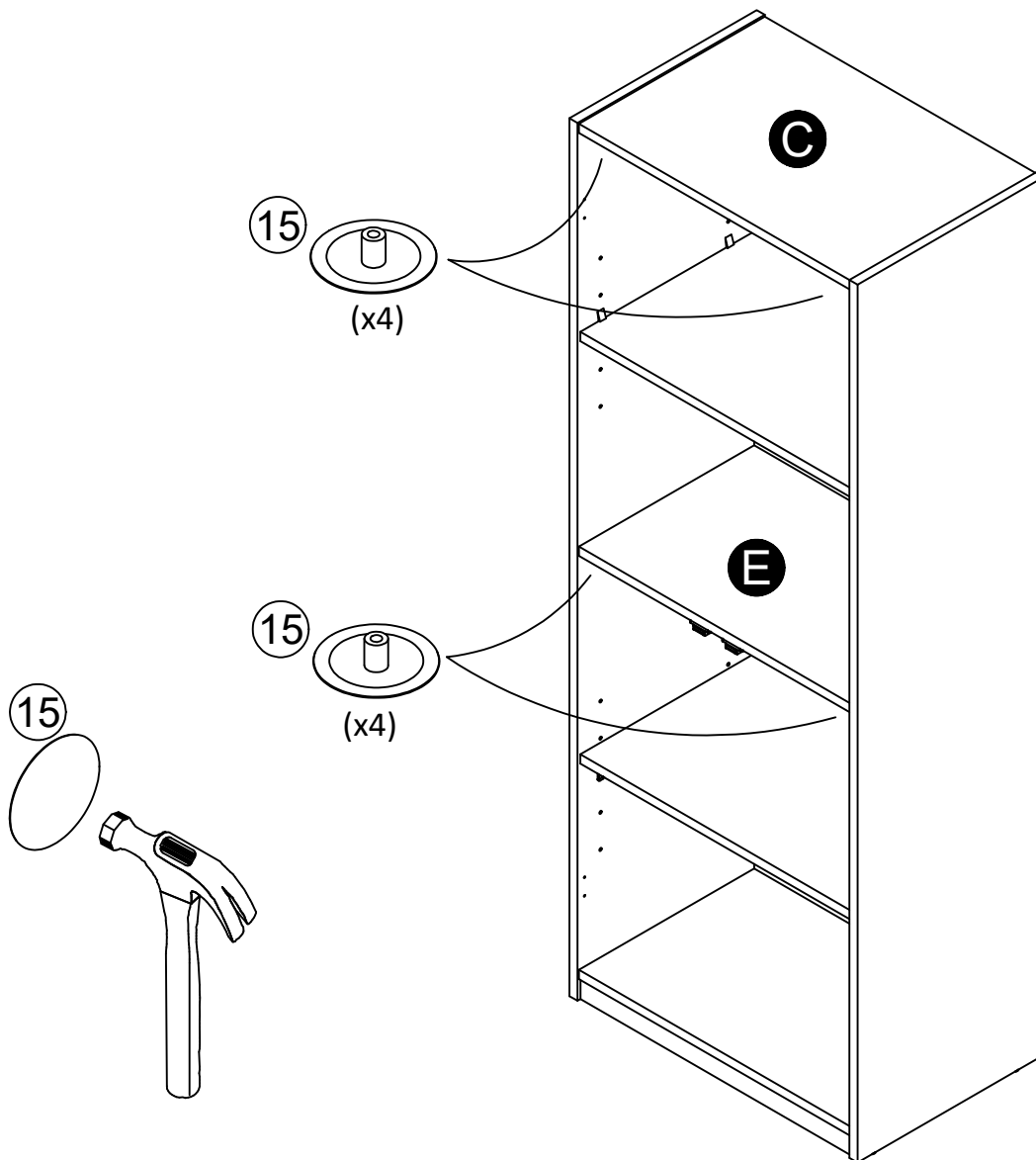
Position the cabinet where you want it. Mark on the wall where the hole in the top of the back panel is. Insert the anchor in the wall where the mark is. Using the screw, attach the cabinet to the anchor.



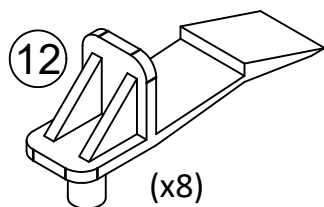
## STEP 14



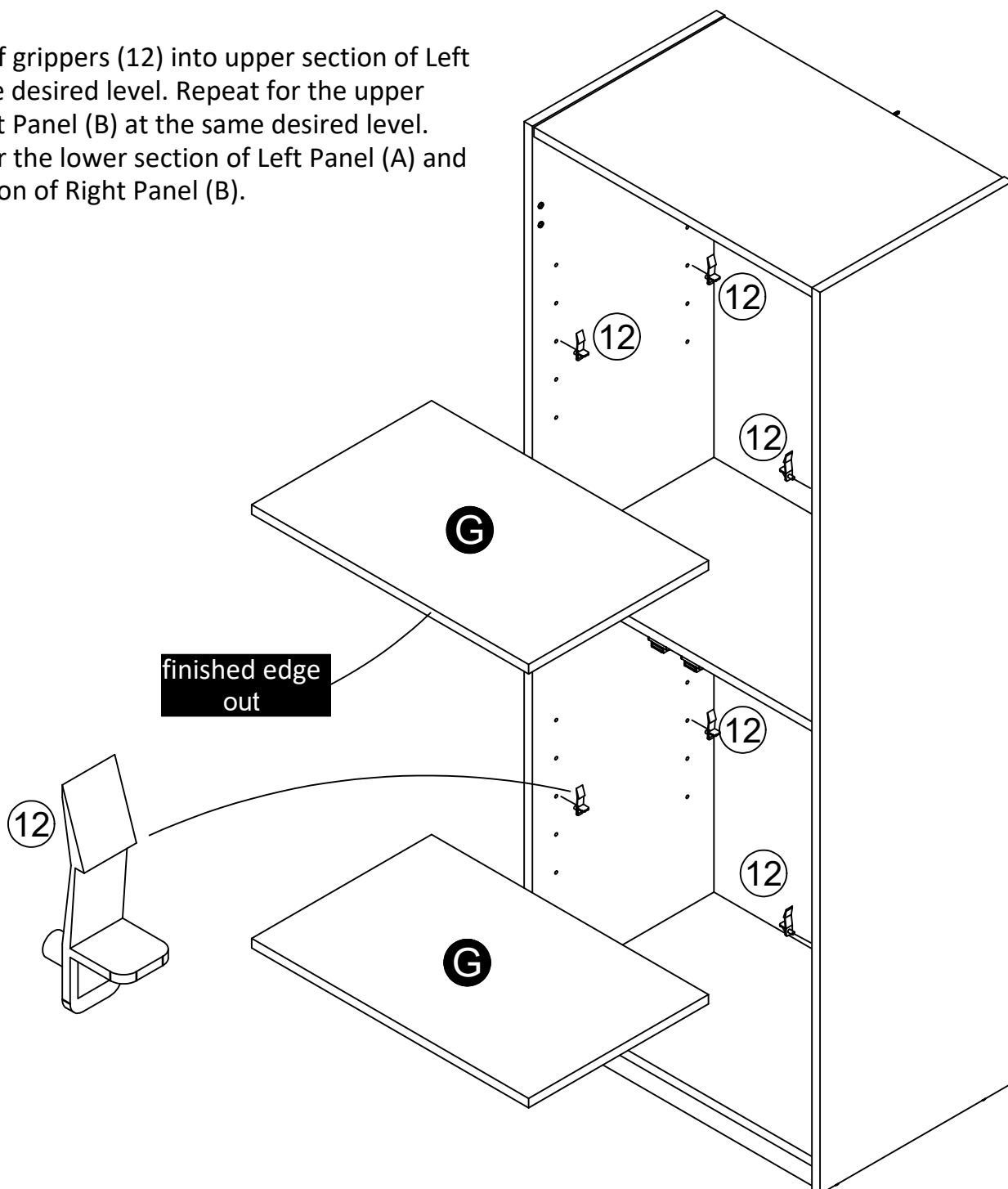
Insert the cam covers (15) into the cam locks (1) in both the Top (C) and Fixed Shelf (E). You'll need to tap the cam covers (15) lightly to securely fasten to the cam locks.



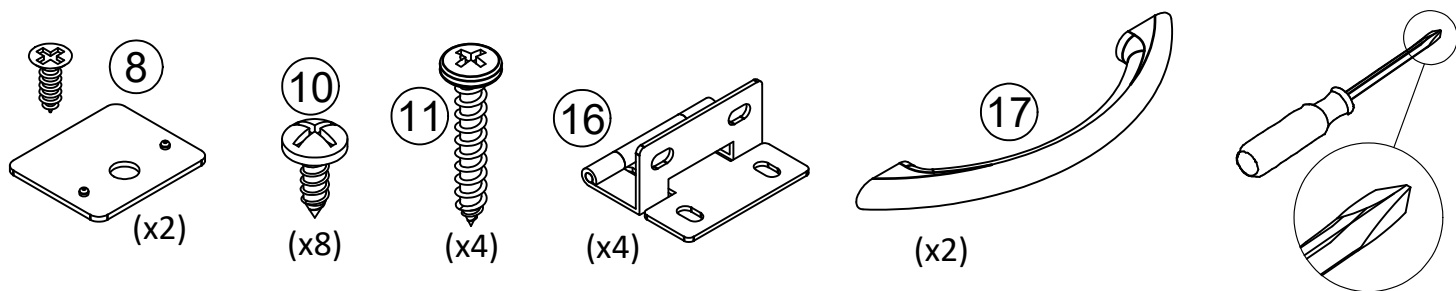
## STEP 15



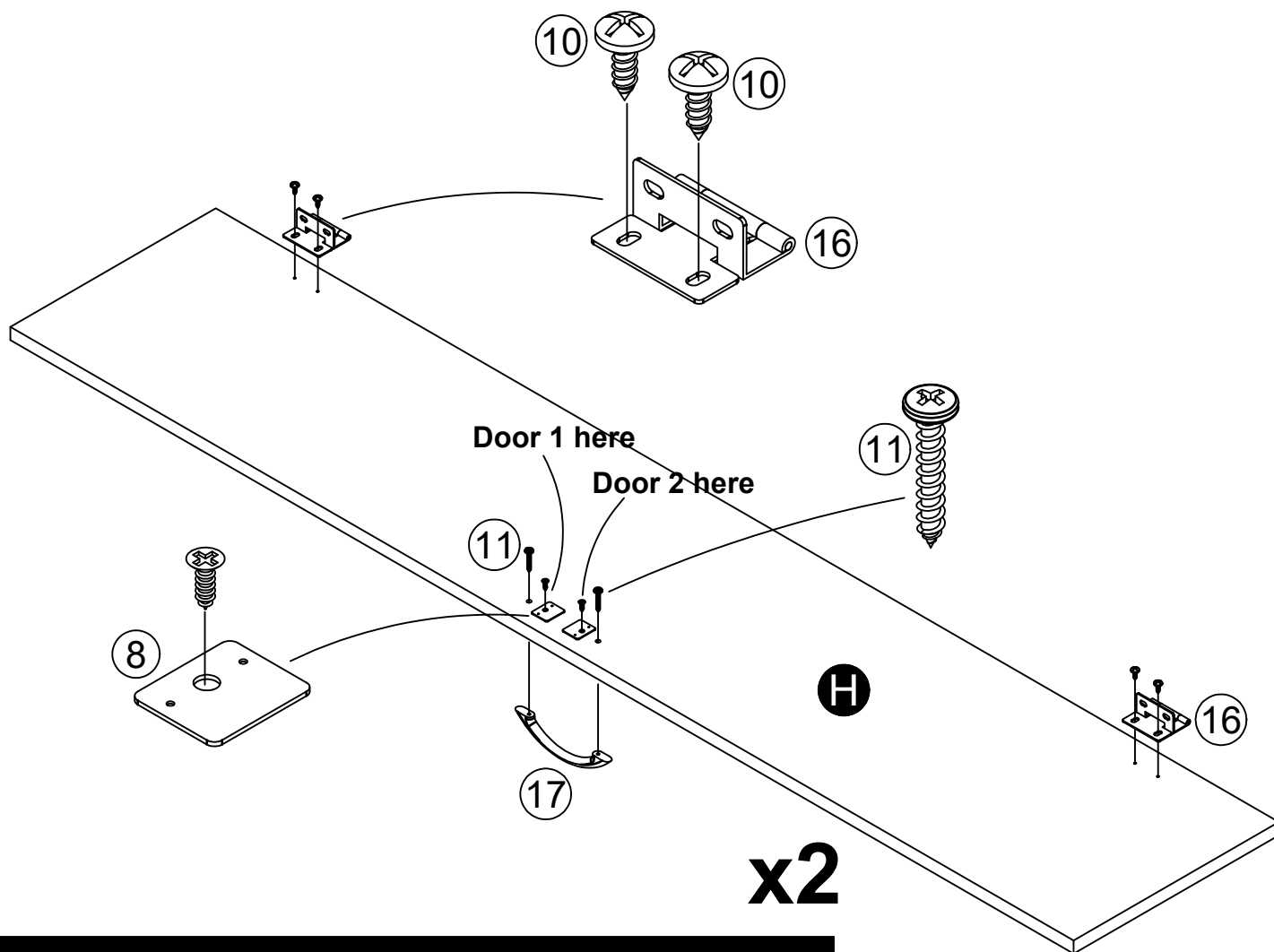
Insert two shelf grippers (12) into upper section of Left Panel (A) at the desired level. Repeat for the upper section of Right Panel (B) at the same desired level. Then repeat for the lower section of Left Panel (A) and the lower section of Right Panel (B).

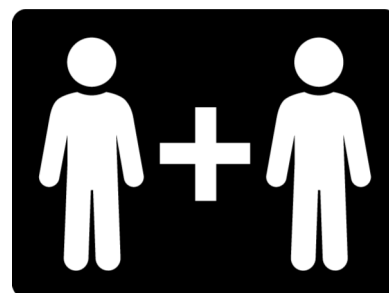
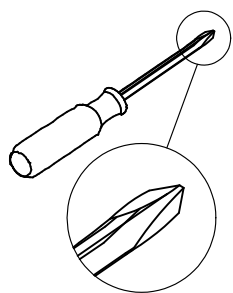


For both Doors, attach the handle using two screws (11), two hinges using four screws (10) and one strike plate (8).



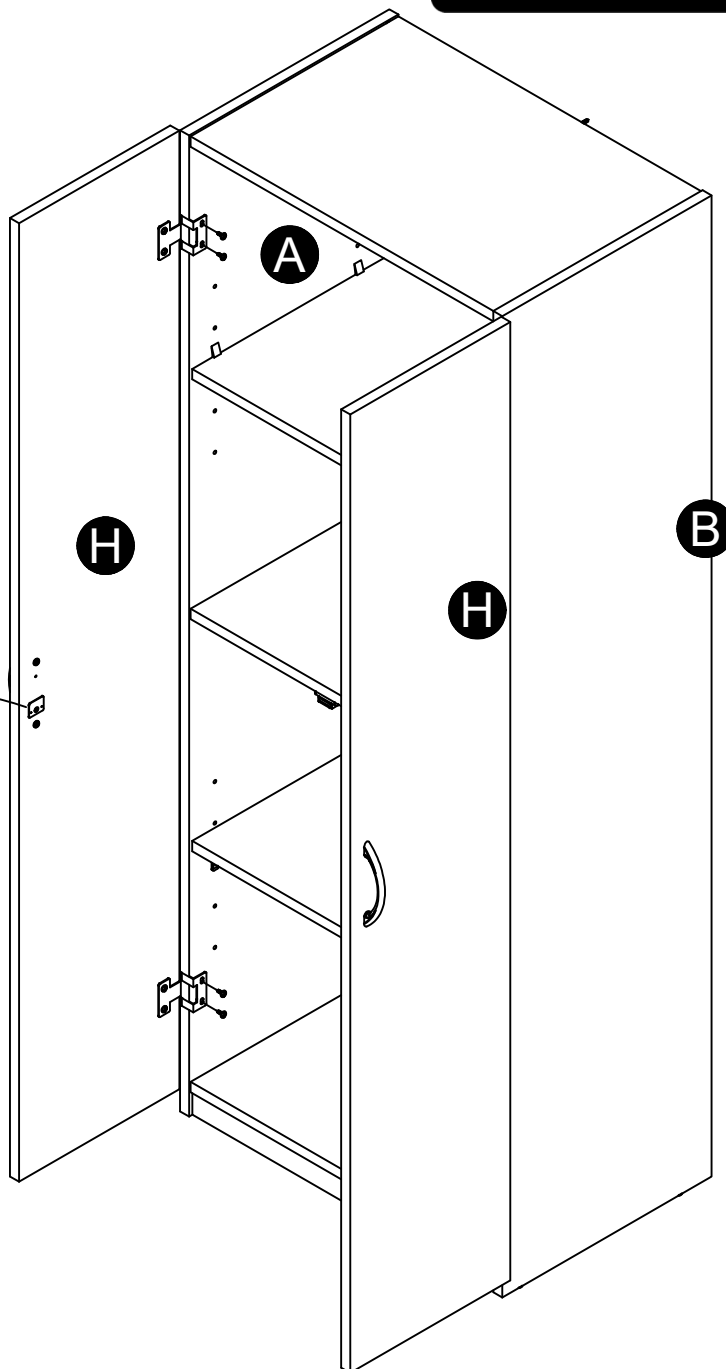
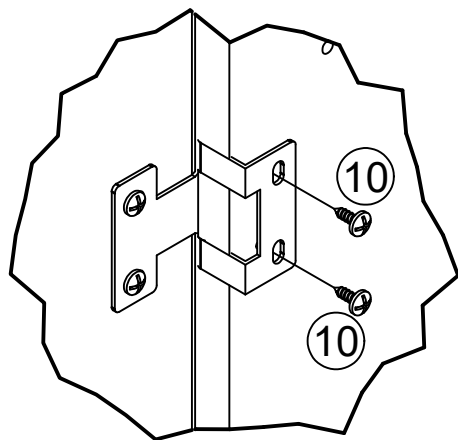
**Note:**  
You will attach one (1) strike plate per door.  
Position the strike plate on one door toward the front and  
position the strike plate on the 2nd door toward the bottom.

# STEP 17



With one person holding the door, attach the door to the Left Panel (A) using four screws (10). Repeat process for the other door attaching to Right Panel (B).

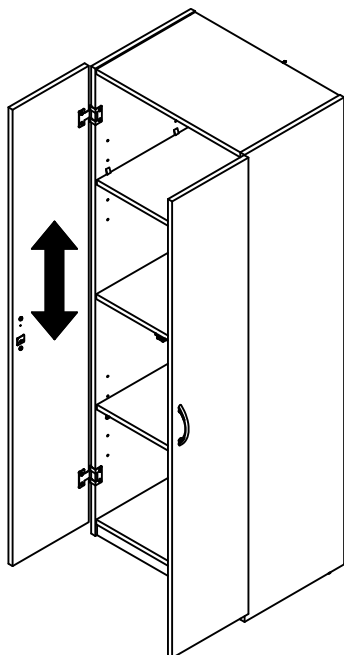

When attaching the doors, be sure the strike plate is in the lower position.





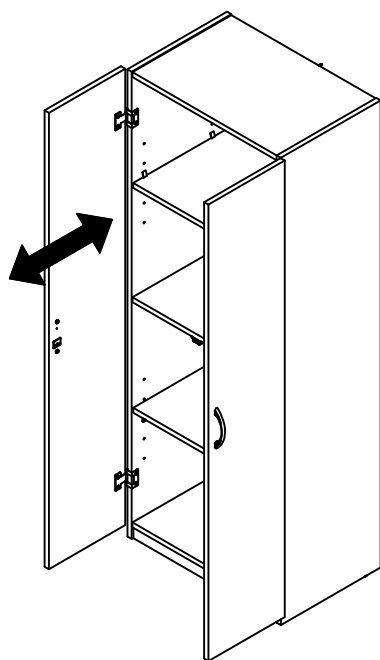
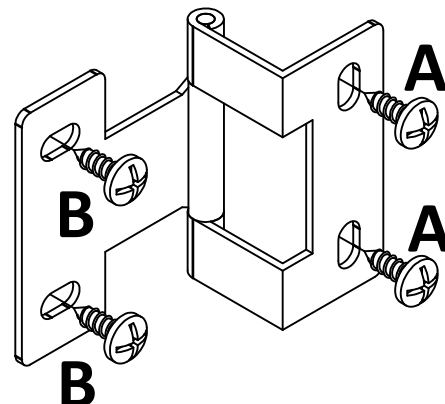
# STEP 18

## Door Adjustment



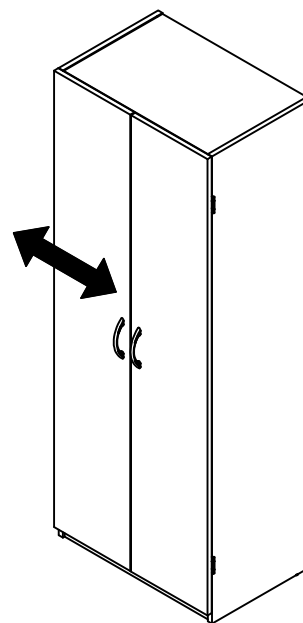
### To adjust the vertical height:

Loosen the screws "A" on both hinges. They are in slotted holes which allows you to adjust up or down by a few mm. Then tighten back up.



### To adjust the depth:

Loosen the screw "B" and adjust door.

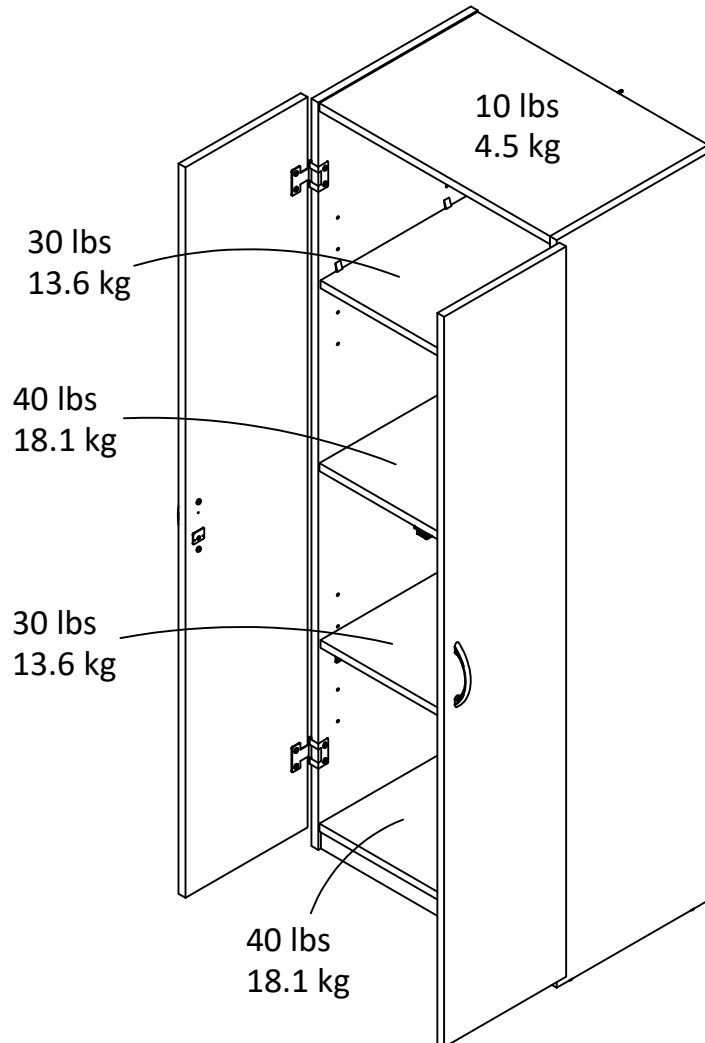


### To adjust side to side:

Loosen the screw "B" on both hinges. They are in slotted holes which allows you to adjust sideways by a few mm. Then tighten back up.
